What is Disqus?

Disqus, pronounced discuss, is a service for blog comments. Disqus enables bloggers to make the conversations on their blogs more interactive and manageable. Disqus supports integration with Gravatar, Facebook, Twitter, and other social networks. As of August 10, 2010, the service had over 13 million registered users and 500,000 communities

When a user visits one of the websites using Disqus and posts a comment, the comment is submitted to Disqus. If the user has a Disqus account, then it tracks all their comments across the websites that use Disqus.



Social Integration (Facebook, Twitter, Google, etc)

Visitors don't need a user account to post comments on any Disqus thread...you can use a Disqus account, your Facebook account, Twitter account, Google account, and many more.



Posting as a Guest (without a Disqus or WM account)

One of the best things about Disqus is that you don't need an account at all on Disqus or on WrestleMation.com. All you have to do is start typing your comment and when done just click the "Post as ..." button to fill out your guest information.
